Deduce or Die

Interrogation

- 1. Select two cards to define a range.
- 2. If cards of the same suit, question applies to that suit only.
- 3. If cards of different suits, question applies to all suits.
- 4. If cards identical, player can ask about either:
 a. all cards of that rank, or b. all cards of that suit

Accusing the Murderer

- 1. Identify the two evidence cards.
- 2. The murder card is equal to the sum of the cards.
- 3. If the cards are of the same suit, the murder card is also of the suit. If the cards are of different suits, the murder card is of the third suit.
- 4. If the sum is greater than 9, subtract 9 from the total.
- 5. The player holding the murder card is the murderer. If no one is holding it, the next higher card of the same suit that is held is the murder card.
- 6. The player holding the murder card needs to determine the player holding the next higher held card of the same suit.
- 7. May accuse at any time. Write the solution on the sheet, examine the evidence and ask to see the accused's cards.
